## 11th call BRIDGE "Proof of Concept"

It is still possible to apply for the 11th round of the funding scheme "Proof of Concept". BRIDGE is a joint program conducted by the Swiss National Science Foundation (SNSF) and Innosuisse - the Swiss Innovation Agency. It offers funding opportunities at the intersection of basic research and science-based innovation. Projects can be submitted via the mySNF platform.

# SNF - Investigator Initiated Clinical Trials (IICT) 2019

<u>The IICT programme</u> of the SNF is targeted at researchers who wish to conduct an investigator initiated clinical trial. Support will be given to trials that address a documented unmet medical need and are of value to the patients but not in industry focus.

The submission deadline for letters of itent is July 1, 2019 and for applications November 1, 2019.



## CYBATHLON 2020 – Moving people and technology

The second <u>CYBATHLON</u> will take place in the SWISS Arena in Kloten, from 2-3 May 2020.

The competition takes the latest assistive technologies for people with physical disabilities and puts them to the test. There will be a reunion with familiar and new teams from all over the world, who will compete in obstacle courses featuring new challenges.
