Welcome, **David Koch!** He recently started his Ph.D. in the RoLSSroice research group led by PD Dr. med. Cordula Netzer (Spine Surgery, University Hospital Basel) and Prof. Dr. Stephen Ferguson (ETH Zurich). During his studies in sports science, David has worked as a research assistant in the Functional Biomechanics research group led by Prof. Annegret Mündermann. For his MA thesis, he has conducted a pilot study ahead of the SNSF-funded RoLSSroice project around the effect of age, lumbar spinal stenosis and paraspinal muscle fatigue on static and dynamic sagittal spinal balance. Within the RoLSSroice research group, David will conduct his research on the role of spinal load in the pathophysiology of lumbar spinal stenosis and is responsible for all experimental aspects of the study.

University Basel Propelling Grant - 5th Ed. Fall 2022 / 1st Call for Applicants

The fund will provide up to 50k CHF for up to 6 months, as non-dilutive funding. In addition, the Innovation Office offers skill-building, mentoring and access to a network of international partners. Project funding

Under the <u>project funding</u> scheme, qualified researchers define their research themes and objectives themselves and conduct their project under their own responsibility. Submission deadline: October 1, 2022.

Agora

The Agora scheme aims to promote the spread of knowledge, as well as the exchange of views and perspectives about scientific research. It therefore encourages projects involving two-way processes - with interaction and listening - which generate dialogues between researchers and the public. Submission deadline: October 10, 2022.

Ambizione

<u>Ambizione</u> grants are aimed at young researchers who wish to conduct, manage and lead an independent project at a Swiss higher education institution. Submission deadline: November 1, 2022.

SNSF Advanced Grants 2022

Grants for leading researchers who want to conduct innovative, high-risk research in Switzerland. Switzerland is still considered a non-associated third country in the Horizon Europe program. On behalf of the federal government, the SNSF is launching a new call for its transitional measure "SNSF Advanced Grants" in 2022, aimed at researchers who intended to apply for an ERC Advanced Grant. Submission deadline: November 2, 2022.
