


to Esma Tankus and Jokin Zubizarreta from Smart Implants

Imaging Zebrafish Larvae to Evaluate Future Drugs

Future drugs must be tested to see if they harm the kidney. Cell-based assays are often used for this purpose, although it is difficult to extrapolate the results to vertebrates. Researchers of the Biomaterials Science Center and the MiNa Core Facility of the DBE together with pharmaceutical technologists and French beamline scientists have evaluated whether zebrafish larvae could serve as a vertebrate screening model to detect changes of renal organs induced by the antibiotic gentamicin. 
Entrepreneurship Training Innosuisse Start-up Training Module 1 & 2 - Central Region

<u>Practice-to-Science grants</u> are aimed at qualified experts with sound practical experience who wish to return to academia as professors at a university of applied sciences or a university of teacher education. Submission deadline: October 3, 23.

SNSF Consolidator Grants

The scheme is intended for researchers who intended to apply for an <u>ERC Consolidator Grant</u> with the aim of conducting research in Switzerland and consolidating their scientific independence. Submission deadline: October 16, 23.

Spirit

<u>SPIRIT</u> facilitates knowledge exchange between researchers in Switzerland and researchers in a range of low- and middle-income countries. Submission deadline: November 2, 23.
