#### to the development of a novel x-ray contrast agent « XlinCA ».

In the framework of the SNSF-funded project HR-Kidney - High Resolution 3D Functional Anatomy Database of the Kidney (153523), Prof. Bert Müller (Biomaterials Science Center) and his colleagues from the University of Zurich have developed the X-ray contrast agent «XlinCA», which enables the smallest blood vessels to be visualized much more precisely than before using computed tomography. Prof. Bert Müller, Dr. Georg Schulz and Griffin Rodgers are co-authors of an (accepted) publication in SMALL. Based on the unique  $\mu$ CT data, Jan Stephan Bolten from the Institute of Pharmaceutical Technology at the University of Basel has produced an image, which won the <u>first prize in the SNC Nano Image Award 2020</u>. The cash contribution was sponsored by the Swiss MNT network. The impressive picture shows clustered superparamagnetic iron oxide nanoparticles within a zebrafish embryo.

## ERC Advanced Grant Call: Deadline August 26, 2020

<u>ERC Advanced Grant</u> Principal Investigators are expected to be active researchers and to have a track record of significant research achievements in their field during the last 10 years. A competitive Advanced Grant Principal Investigator must have already shown a record which identifies them as an exceptional leader in terms of originality and significance of their research contributions. #### Agora

The Agora scheme aims to promote the spread of knowledge, as well as the exchange of views and perspectives about scientific research. It therefore encourages projects involving two-way processes - with interaction and listening - which generate dialogues between researchers and the public. The submission deadline is September 1, 2020.

#### Indo-Swiss Joint Research Programme: call for proposals with India


Within the scope of the bilateral programmes of the Swiss Confederation, the SNSF and the Indian Department of Biotechnology (DBT) are issuing a call for proposals. The submission deadline is September 11, 2020.

#### Spirit (rolling call for pre-proposals)

The Swiss Programme Spirit for International Research by Scientific Investigation Teams promotes team-oriented cross-border research. The evaluation process comprises two phases: pre-proposals can be submitted all year round, full proposals only by invitation after approval of the pre-proposal. The Submission deadline is September 30, 2020.

#### **Investigator Initiated Clinical Trials (IICT) 2020**

The special programme for Investigator Initiated Clinical Trials (IICTs) of the Swiss National Science Foundation supports clinical studies on under researched topics that meet medical as well as social needs. These letters of intent need to be submitted using the mySNF. The deadline for submitting proposals on mySNF is November 2, 2020.


## Good to know
