Calls & Research Funding Deadlines

BRIDGE Proof of Concept

The new call for <u>BRIDGE Proof of Concept</u> projects is open until June 7, 2021. Young researchers who want to apply their research results and realize an innovative product or service can submit their project proposal.

Postdoc.Mobility

<u>Postdoc.Mobility</u> fellowships support postdocs who wish to conduct a research stay abroad. The fellowships are aimed at researchers with a doctorate and at researchers who will complete their doctorate within nine months after the submission deadline. Researchers with a medical degree that includes a doctorate are also eligible to apply. The submission deadline is August 1, 2021.

Call for NRP 79

The Swiss National Science Foundation (SNSF) launches a call for the National Research Programme "Advancing 3R - Animals, Research and Society" (NRP 79) based on a mandate from the Federal Council. NRP 79 "Advancing 3R" aims to address the tensions between medical research and animal welfare and to improve research involving animals. Interested researchers can submit their pre-proposals for <u>NRP 79</u> until August 3, 2021.
