

#### on the DBE Double Success at BRCCH Principal Investigator Initiative

Dr. Edgar Delgado-Eckert and Dr. Robin Sandkühler & Prof. Philippe Cattin have been successful at the PII scheme of the Botnar Research Center for Child Health. Dr. Delgado-Eckert's project is called "Alex: Design, Development and Evaluation of a Digital Health Assistant for Paediatric Asthma". It aims to improve asthma control in children and adolescents using a Digital Health Assistant (DHA) designed for regular and sustained remote disease monitoring and patient coaching.

The project of Dr. Sandkühler and Prof. Cattin is called "Visual Analysis of Long-Lasting Insecticidal Nets to Maximise Universal Access". It addresses the problem that long-lasting insecticidal nets (LLINs) – the mainstay of malaria control – often develop holes and wear out sooner than their expected lifespan. ## to ThINk on a major publication and a grant by Hasler Stiftung

The Haslerstiftung in Berne will fund a project conceived by Meritxell Bach Cuadra (Lausanne University Hospital) and co-applicant Prof. Cristina Granziera. The project's title is "Explaining AI decisions in personalized healthcare: towards integration of deep learning into diagnosis and treatment planning (MSxplain)" and will be funded for three years with almost 450.000 CHF.

The research group ThINk is in the driving seat of a study published in the highly prestigious JAMA Neurology Journal. Its title is "Association of Brain Atrophy with Disease Progression Independent of Relapse Activity in Patients with Relapsing Multiple Sclerosis" with Dr. Alessandro Cagol appearing as first and Cristina Granziera as last authors.
