The Swiss National Science Foundation is funding the research group for Facial and Cranial Anomalies of PD Dr. Andreas Mueller for a 4-year project called (Learning-based 3D Infant Face and Head Model for Medical Applications). The project will be conducted in cooperation with the Computer Graphics Laboratory of the ETH Zurich together with Prof. Dr. Markus Gross and Dr. Barbara Solenthaler. Calls & Research Funding Deadlines



Invite your Expert

<u>"Invite your expert"</u> enables PPHS students to receive funding for inviting an expert in their respective field to give a talk. In this way, students can get in direct contact with experts to discuss their research topic. In a virtual or hybrid manner, the students also have the possibility to meet the expert's lab members and can apply for financial and logistical support. The submission deadline is November 1, 2021.

SPIRIT

<u>SPIRIT</u> facilitates knowledge exchange between researchers in Switzerland and researchers in a range of low- and middle-income countries. The topics are chosen by the researchers themselves. The submission deadline is November 2, 2021.

Indo-Swiss Joint Research Program 2021

The SNSF and its Indian partners, the Ministry of Earth Sciences in India (MoES) and the Indian Council of Social Sciences Research (ICSSR) are launching a <u>call for Joint Research Projects (JRPs)</u>. JRPs enable scientists in Switzerland to collaborate with research partners in India. The call supports research and development projects in two different research fields, one under the MoES, the other under the ICSSR. The submission deadline is November 30, 2021.



SNSF Advanced Grants

Following Switzerland's non-association to Horizon Europe, the SNSF is launching this call on the government's behalf to support researchers who intended to apply for an ERC Advanced Grant in 2021. The call is open for applicants of any nationality who want to pursue innovative, high-risk research in Switzerland. The submission deadline is December 1, 2021.

Find here further calls for proposals of the SNSF like "Sinergia" or "BRIDGE Proof of Concept" and funding shemes with a submission deadline beginning of December 2021.



National MD-PhD Program

With the support of private foundations and in collaboration with the Swiss School of Public Health, the SAMS and the Swiss National Science Foundation award each year a limited number of competitive individual MD-PhD grants. The aim of the program is to equip medical doctors interested in research with the skills necessary for a career as clinician and scientist. The submission deadline is December 15, 2021.
