to Dr. Claudia Lenz on her SNF Grant

Dr. Claudia Lenz has won a SNF grant for her project <u>"The role of tissue anisotropy in quantitative MRI of the human brain"</u>. The project was applied for under the Weave agreement, with SNSF as lead agency, and will be conducted in collaboration with Prof. Christoph Birkl from the Medical University of Innsbruck. Both partners receive funding for 4 years (CHF 590'838 for Basel, 383'237 Euro for Innsbruck).

Prof. Oliver Bieri has been awarded with a SNF Grant for his project "MRI from Low to High Field: The Next Generation of Balanced Steady State Free Precession Methods". The project was granted with more than CHF 700'000.

Dr. Francesco Santini has won a SNF grant with more than CHF 750'000 for his project "Advancing Neuromuscular Disease Evaluation: Developing Novel Multiparametric MRI Methods for Myotonic Dystrophy Assessment and Management". Furthermore Dr. Santini was elected as an Executive Board Member of the European Society of Magnetic Resonance in Medicine and Biology (ESMRMB) for a 4-year cycle as membership, media, and marketing officer.


The Knife is Not Enough

National MD-PhD Grants Program

The SAMS, together with the SNF and the support of private foundations as well as the collaboration with the Swiss School of Public Health, award each year a limited number of competitive individual MD-PhD grants. The aim of the program is to equip medical doctors interested in research with the skills necessary for a career as clinician and scientist. Submission deadline: December 15, 23.

PROMYS – Support for researchers in Bulgaria

The new <u>PROMYS</u> program supports researchers from EU-27 countries or Switzerland who are seeking an assistant professorship in Bulgaria. Submission deadline: November 30, 23.

SNSF Swiss Postdoctoral Fellowships (SPF)

<u>Grants</u> for early-career researchers wishing to consolidate their scientific training and pursue their academic career in Switzerland. Submission deadline: December 1, 23.

Collaborating with researchers from Ukraine

The SNSF is launching a joint call for proposals with the Ukrainian funding agency NRFU. One of the aims is to maintain research activity in Ukraine, and to reduce brain drain from the country. Submission deadline: December 12, 23.
