#### **Titular Professorship for Prof. Cordula Netzer**

Cordula is the first woman in Switzerland to be appointed titular professor in spine surgery. She is Head of the Spine Center and Senior Consultant in Spine Surgery at the University Hospital Basel. At the DBE, she leads the Translational Spine Research and Biomechanics Group and serves as the medical lead for the Core Facility CADENCE Clinical Biomechanics & Ergonomics Engineering. Her clinical focus is on spinal tumor surgery and her research focus is in the area of degenerative spine diseases. Read more.



#### Dr. Peter Wahl and Dr. Ferda Canbaz receive CHF 2.9 million on their SNSF Project

Led by Peter, a multidisciplinary team has secured an SNSF research grant for the project "Comprehensive analysis of determinants of polyethylene wear and the related tissue response to improve outcomes in total hip arthroplasty." The initiative—co-led by Ferda, and other external partners—was awarded CHF 2.9 million in funding to be spent over four years. Read more.


#### Call for Junior Group Leaders | Application deadline: 11.05.2026
