#### Professorship in Translational Imaging for Prof. Cristina Granziera

Cristina is appointed Clinical Professor of Translational Imaging at the Faculty of Medicine at the University Hospital Basel (USB). She is senior physician at the Neurology Department at the USB, research group leader for ThINK, and co-CEO of the Research Center for Clinical Neuroimmunology and Neuroscience Basel (RC2NB). Her research is dedicated to elucidating the pathophysiological mechanisms of neuroinflammatory, neurodegenerative, and cerebrovascular diseases and translating these insights into innovative approaches for diagnosis, prognosis, and therapy. 
#### Dr. Anna Stoll awarded a Research Grant for Excellent Junior Researchers

Anna is a postdoctoral researcher at the Institute of Forensic Medicine of the University of Basel and has been awarded a grant from the Research Fund for Excellent Junior Researchers for her project "Investigations on phytochemicals in Cannabis sativa and their quantification in human blood." The one-year grant, totaling CHF 80,000, supports her work on identifying novel biomarkers that can reliably indicate recent cannabis consumption. [Read more.](#)



#### Nanoargovia grant for Dr. Zarah Walsh-Korb in DBE-FHNW-PSI consortium

Led by Dr. Sina Saxer (FHNW), and co-led by Dr. Zarah Walsch-Korb (DBE) and Dr. Thomas Huthwelker (PSI), the project "μ-Almond - Study of unresolved calcium carbonate microcrystal synthesis with an electric anti-fouling device" will study novel calcium carbonate formulations produced in situ by commercial electric anti-fouling devices from the industrial partner Hydro Service Schweiz AG. The project aims to examine their fundamental structure up to their interaction with intestinal tissue through consumption of treated water. The project received CHF 143,000 and will initially run for one year.

Alina Dokgöz and Sven Zaugg, two students in our Master's programme, have each won an SNI Image Award. Each year, the Swiss Nanoscience Institute (SNI) at the University of Basel honors the most fascinating images of the micro- and nanoworld generated within the framework of research projects. 




**ERC Plus grants: a new opportunity for ambitious research | Submission deadline: 02.09.26**
