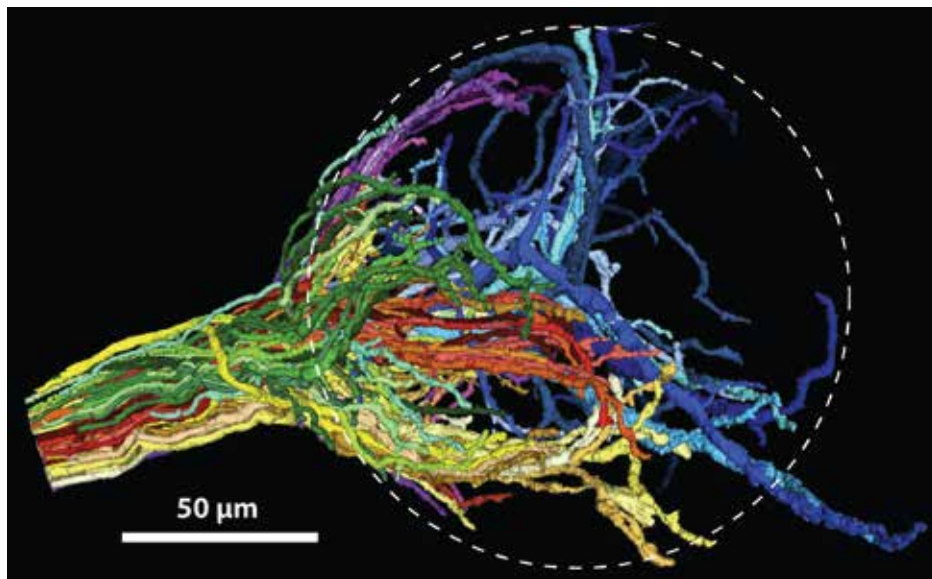

Hard X-ray nano-tomography for deep and precise exploration of biological samples

Hard X-ray nano-tomography at cryogenic temperatures is a game changer in biomedical imaging. This talk covers recent advances in X-ray holography, a coherent imaging technique offering exceptional contrast in soft tissues, and in X-ray fluorescence microscopy for precise mapping of chemical composition. These advancements address fundamental challenges in biomedical research such as deciphering neuronal circuits.
